

UBC ENERGY & WATER SERVICES MANHOLE ENTRY PERMIT

This permit is required by all Contractors planning to enter any electrical/communication manhole (or other permit-required manhole) within the jurisdiction of UBC. This permit must be signed by the personnel entering the manhole. This permit is valid only for the dates and manhole numbers indicated. A separate permit for each manhole is required. A signed and approved copy of this permit must be located at the manhole site. No entry attempt shall be made without an approved permit.
